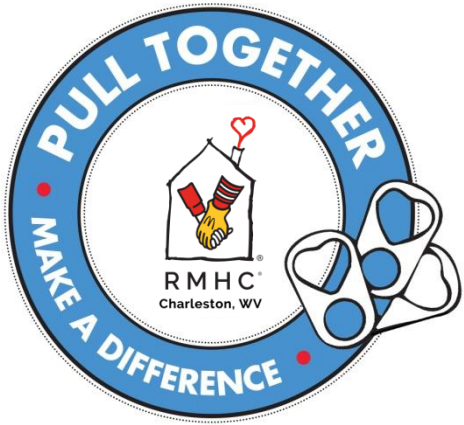


# POP TAB PROGRAM



**The Pop Tab Program** is a fundraising project to support Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern West Virginia. By saving the tabs from all aluminum cans, you can join the hundreds of groups throughout WV who are generously contributing to the Charity. Each donated pop tab helps provide a home away from home for families of seriously ill children.

The Pop Tab Program has been in existence for many years at RMHC. The funds help provide nights of rest for families during the most difficult times of their lives. We need the support of the local community to continue making this program a success.

## Pop Tab Program FAQ

**Q: What types of tabs should I collect?**

A: We collect all types of aluminum tabs from items such as soda cans, soup cans, pet food cans, or vegetable cans.

**Q: Where do I take my pop tabs?**

A: There are two ways you can donate your pop tabs:

**1.** Drop off your tabs at Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern West Virginia, 7 days a week, between the hours of 9 am and 9 pm.

**2. Take your pop tabs to a nearby recycler.**

Ask them to weigh your tabs and make the check out to Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern West Virginia. Mail the check to our address above and include your contact information so we may thank you!

**Q: What happens to the pop tabs once you receive them?**

A: Pop tabs come to the House in a variety of containers. We empty them from these containers and combine them in a large trash can. Once we have filled up our storage space, we take the tabs to a local recycler. There, the tabs are weighed and then we are given a check for the current market value of the aluminum. All funds raised through the Pop Tab Program are used to support RMHC's mission.
